President Biden's COVID-19 Executive Orders

President Biden has signed several Executive Orders since taking office as the 46th President of the United States, which are designed to help contain the COVID-19 crisis, including:

- President Biden's COVID-19 Action Plan, which requires, among other things, that all employers with 100+ employees to ensure their workers are vaccinated or tested weekly;
- Executive Order on Protecting the Federal Workforce and Requiring Mask Wearing, which requires facemasks, physical distancing and adherence to CDC guidelines while on federal lands;
- Executive Order on Promoting COVID-19 Safety in Domestic and International Travel, which requires facemasks to be worn in airports and on public transportation, and all travelers entering the United States to test negative for COVID-19 and to comply with other applicable CDC guidelines concerning international travel, including to quarantine upon arrival; and
