## President Biden's COVID-19 Executive Orders

President Biden has signed several Executive Orders since taking office as the 46th President of the United States, which are designed to help contain the COVID-19 crisis, including:

- an [Executive Order on Protecting the Federal Workforce and Requiring Mask Wearing](#), which requires facemasks, physical distancing and adherence to CDC guidelines while on federal lands;
- an [Executive Order on Promoting COVID-19 Safety in Domestic and International Travel](#), which requires facemasks to be worn in airports and on public transportation, and all travelers entering the United States to test negative for COVID-19 and to comply with other applicable CDC guidelines concerning international travel, including to quarantine upon arrival; and
- [Geographic COVID-related Presidential Proclamations](#) suspending entry into the United States of noncitizens of the United States who were physically present within certain countries during the 14-day period preceding their entry or attempted entry into the United States, subject to exceptions specified in the proclamations.
