

Venezuela: Decreto Presidencial creó la Aduana Subalterna de Tienditas

Resumen

El Decreto Presidencial No. 4.752 de fecha 07 de diciembre de 2022, publicado en la Gaceta Oficial No. 42.521, ("**Decreto**")¹, establece la creación de la Aduana Subalterna de Tienditas ("**Aduana**") adscrita a la Gerencia de la Aduana Principal de San Antonio del Táchira.

El Decreto entró en vigencia el 07 de diciembre de 2022.

En detalle

A continuación, las especificaciones del Decreto:

1. El Decreto crea la Aduana Subalterna de Tienditas, adscrita a la Gerencia de la Aduana Principal de San Antonio del Táchira, cuya cede será en el Centro Nacional de Atención Fronteriza ("CENAF").
2. La Aduana estará habilitada para importación, exportación, tránsito, servicios de trasbordo y bultos postales.
3. El Servicio Nacional Integrado de Administración Aduanera y Tributaria ("SENIAT") dictará las Providencias y ejecutará las acciones correspondientes para iniciar las operaciones de la Aduana.
4. El Decreto será ejecutado por el Ministerio del Poder Popular de Economía, Finanzas y Comercio Exterior junto con el Coordinador de la Zona Económica Especial Fronteriza Ureña - San Antonio.
5. El Decreto entrará en vigencia el día de su publicación en Gaceta Oficial.
